REGULATIONS FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Those 14 and older are required to abstain
from eating meat on all Fridays of Lent.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days
of Fast and Abstinence, meaning only one
full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals
may be taken if needed to maintain
strength. In the new Code of Canon Law,
the obligation to fast binds those who are
18 years old or older until their 59th birth-
day.
